FURTHER SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1.1 ORGANISATION & STATUS

- 1.1.1 These Further Regulations apply to the “2020 Liqui Moly Bathurst 12 Hour”, herein referred to as “B12HR”. These Further Regulations are in addition to the Supplementary Regulations published on 07/08/2019.
- 1.1.2 On the 1st January 2020, the Confederation of Australian Motorsport Ltd (CAMS) rebranded to Motorsport Australia.
- 1.1.2.1 All references to CAMS in published regulations for this Event means Motorsport Australia.
- 1.1.3 The Event Schedule is attached and forms part of these regulations.
- 1.1.3.1 Final details of practice, qualifying and race times and the number and length of the races are included in the schedule, but may be varied at the Event. All sessions on the Circuit and Races will normally be treated as “time-certain” and time lost through recovery needs and safety car interventions will not be made up.
- 1.1.4 This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with Motorsport Australia Safety 1st, OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at www.motorsport.org.au.
- 1.1.5 There will be a number of parade laps, various demonstrations, and passenger rides at the Event and they will be conducted in accordance with NCR 20A & 20B and the CAMS Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity Policy.

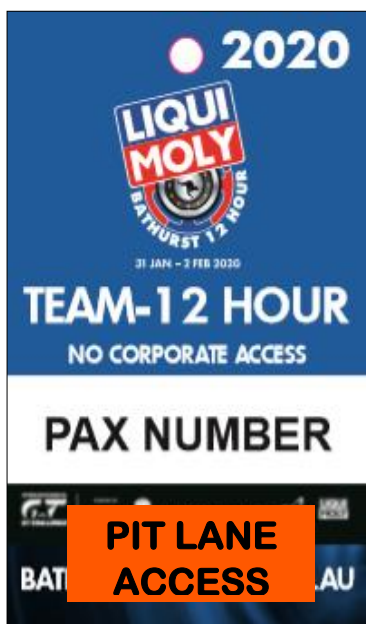
1.3 NOMINATION OF TEAM MANAGER

1.17 LUMIRANK LED POSITION SYSTEM

- 1.17.1 As communicated to all Teams on 13th January 2020, it will be mandatory for all cars entered in the 2020 Liqui-Moly Bathurst 12 Hour to be equipped with a Lumirank LED position windscreen panel.
- 1.17.2 All Lumirank panels are to be returned to Lumirank on Sunday 2nd February 2020 during Parc Fermé.

1.18 WATER RESTRICTIONS

- 1.18.1 From 14th October 2019 Bathurst Region Council has implemented level 4-5 or extreme water restrictions, which is enforced.
